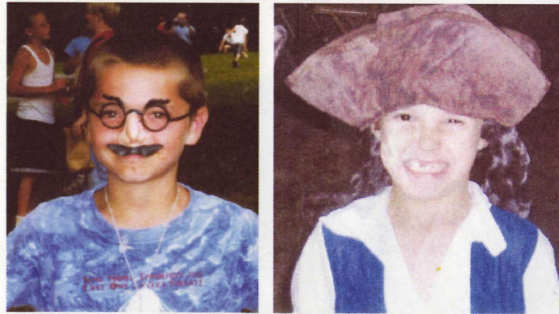


## Who Are We?

Mobile United Methodist Missionaries is a pilot program launched by the Ottumwa District in January 1996. Our purpose is to take the Gospel into areas where there is no church presence and to assist and revitalize local congregations.

During the Flood of 1993, it became apparent there were many needs in the communities across our district that were not being met, which led to the creation of this outreach program.

## Whose Child is This?



Following in the footsteps of our Lord who called the little children unto Himself, the Bishops of the United Methodist Church have initiated a special emphasis, “Whose Child is This?”

In that same spirit, a major emphasis of the Mobile United Methodist Missionaries is children’s ministries.

\*\*Hundreds of children have been touched by Mobile United Methodist Missionaries. (80% of which are unchurched)

\*\*A little girl rode her bicycle, barefooted, on three miles of gravel to attend a MUMMS Bible school event!

\*\*One of the VBS events was held on the very ground where a United Methodist Church stood---where now there is no church presence at all.

\*\*Because of MUMMS, many children are now given an opportunity to attend United Methodist Church Camps.
